Our Lady of the Valley begins its 3rd year in a new Adult Religious Education program called G.I.F.T., which stands for **Growing In Faith and Theology**. GIFT is a collaborative program sponsored by 14 area parishes including: *Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Lady of Good Counsel, Our Lady of Holy Angels, Holy Cross, Holy Spirit, Immaculate Heart of Mary, Our Lady of Consolation, Our Lady of the Magnificat, Our Lady of the Valley, Our Lady Queen of Peace, St. Anthony, St. Francis, St. Joseph and St Mary's*. 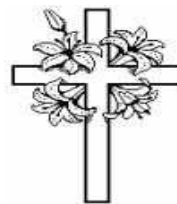
