#### **Correction on OLV Financial Report**

The figures for the student enrollment for our Religious Education Program found on the last page of the financial report need to be corrected. The report shows 641 students enrolled for 07-08. It should have been 570 and 470 enrolled for 08-09 when it should have been 646. This year's enrollment for 09-10 was at 534 as of mid-September. That is a decrease in student enrollment for the Children's Faith formation program of 112 students for the 09-10 school year. The decrease of 112 students at \$220 per student is lost income of \$24,640.

As in all households, expenses (energy, maintenance, etc.) increase each year—our parish is no different. Please keep this expense gap in mind as you determine your planned giving each week. Continued thanks to those who recognize the realistic cost of supporting our parish community.

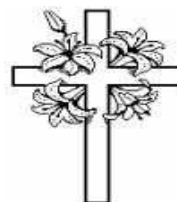
