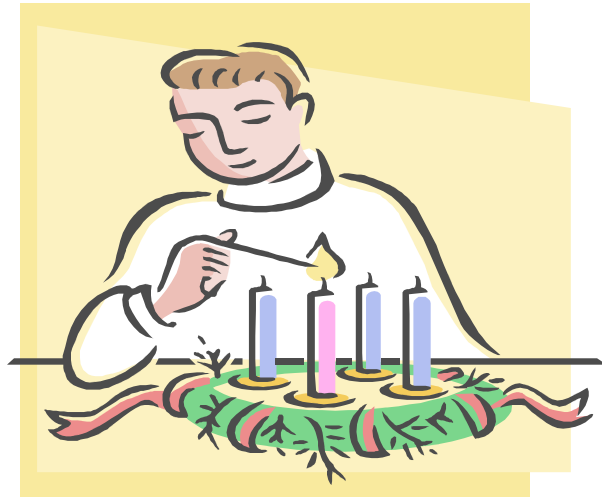

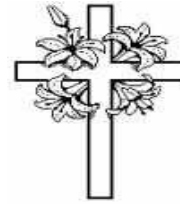
### *Winter Semester of G.I.F.T. Growing in Faith and Theology*
