## **Relic of St. John Vianney Coming to OLV**

Pope Benedict XVI has declared a "Year for Priests" that began on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 19, 2009. The Pope has also declared St. John Vianney the Universal Patron of Priests on the occasion of the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of the Cure Ars. 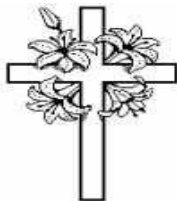
#### **Retrouvaille Program**

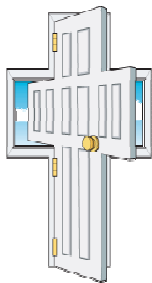

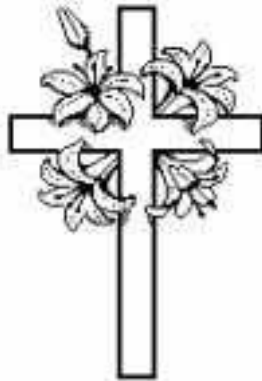
### **Protecting Our Children**

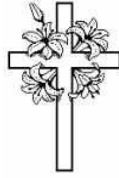
