You might remember in the bulletin in November we had a copy of the **Beacon** bill. Not very many of the 450+ parishioners receiving the **Beacon** have been paying for the subscription leaving the parish to pay for the bulk of this bill. We recently started to clean up our subscription list by removing over 120 names. We will now wait to see how we do with payments that come in before eliminating more names from our list. 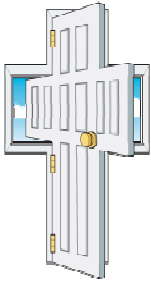
