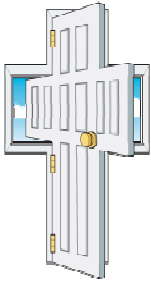

Protecting Our Children

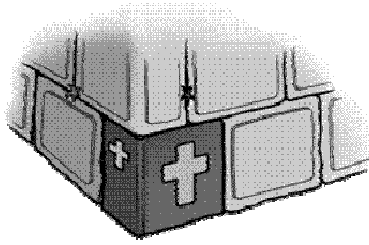

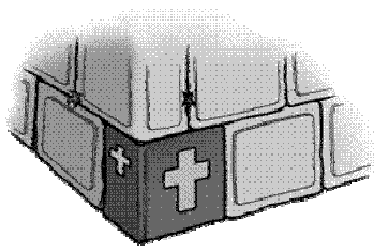
